#### **ORDINANCE NO. 743**

# AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN SECTIONS OF CHAPTER 26 OF THE CITY OF BOX ELDER MUNICIPAL CODE

**WHEREAS,** the City of Box Elder seeks to enhance the clarity and consistency of its ordinances through periodic review; and

**WHEREAS,** the City of Box Elder has reviewed the entirety of its municipal code so that amendments might be made to improve the clarity and consistency of various sections.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the governing body of the City of Box Elder, that the following Sections of Chapter 26 of the City of Box Elder Municipal Code be amended to read as follows:

### **Chapter 26. PARKS AND RECREATION**

## ARTICLE III. CITY PARKS

Sec. 26-51. Hours, Permit for Activities Outside Normal Park Hours.

26-51(b). The responsible party seeking to use city park facilities outside normal operating hours shall file an application with and obtain a permit from the city. Permits shall be issued to persons over 21 years of age who shall be the responsible party for the activity authorized by the permit. The responsible party shall be responsible for the people attending the permitted event and must provide proof of the permit to law enforcement if asked to do so.

Sec. 26-53. Pets Allowed Only On Leash; Authority Of Board To Establish Pet Control Areas.

26-53(a). No pets are allowed in the city parks, except on a leash. Pets must be under control at all times. No pets shall be allowed within 25 feet of any baseball or softball field, basketball court or other areas designated for games of any kind. Owners or the responsible party in possession of a pet(s) are responsible to clean-up after the animal while utilizing any public infrastructure.
