RESOLUTION NO. 24-06

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR A UTILITIES ROUND-UP PROGRAM TO THE CITY OF BOX ELDER UTILITY SYSTEM TO FINANCE THE BLACK HILLS CHILDREN'S MUSEUM

WHEREAS, the City of Box Elder has assisted in formation and support for the not-for-profit Black Hills Children's Museum, Inc. The charitable purpose of Black Hills Children's Museum, Inc. is to construct and operate a Children's Museum within the city limits of the City of Box Elder; and

WHEREAS, the City of Box Elder has determined to start a voluntary utilities round-up program to finance the Black Hills Children's Museum; and

WHEREAS, the City of Box Elder will add an option on city utility bills for customers to voluntarily sign up to "round up" their monthly utility bill to the nearest dollar; and

WHEREAS, the maximum investment in any month would be 99 cents, and in a year, \$11.88; and

WHEREAS, the funds collected by the City through utility billing round-up will be transferred to Black Hills Children's Museum, Inc. for the assistance of that organization.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOX ELDER:

Hereby establishes a voluntary utility round-up program where city utilities users can voluntarily opt in to round up their utility bill by a maximum of 99 cents per month and \$11.88 in a year to help finance the Black Hills Children's Museum. The funds will be transferred to the Black Hills Children's Museum on a regular basis as determined by City Staff.
