A RESOLUTION TEMPORARILY WAIVING THE \$15 LATE FEE ON DELINQUENT UTILTIY BILLS DUE TO THE TYLER TECHNOLOGIES UTILITY BILLING SOFTWARE MIGRATION

WHEREAS, the City's utility billing system is undergoing a software migration that will temporarily delay applying payments to the customer accounts; and

WHEREAS, delinquent utility bills effective March 17, 2025, would normally incur a \$15 late fee as specified in the Master Fee Schedule; and

WHEREAS, customers may be unable to make payments between the due date and the penalty date due to the temporary system limitations beyond their control; and

WHEREAS, the City seeks to ensure fair and responsible billing practices during this transition period;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Box Elder, that:

- 1. The \$15 late fee on delinquent utility bills, as outlined in the Master Fee Schedule, shall be temporarily waived for the month of March.
- 2. This waiver shall apply to all delinquent accounts that would have otherwise incurred a late fee during the period of system migration.
- 3. Normal billing and late fee assessments will resume once the software migration is complete,
- 4. Customers on the shut-off list for the end of the month, will be processed as normal, however there will not be a \$15 late fee for the month of March on their final bill.
