RESOLUTION NO. 25-23

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR A VOLUNTARY ROUND-UP PROGRAM ON CITY TRANSACTIONS TO SUPPORT THE BLACK HILLS CHILDREN'S MUSEUM, AND REPEALING AND REPLACING RESOLUTION NO. 24-06

WHEREAS, the City of Box Elder has assisted in the formation and ongoing support of the not-for-profit Black Hills Children's Museum, Inc., whose charitable purpose is to construct and operate a Children's Museum within the city limits of the City of Box Elder; and

WHEREAS, the City of Box Elder has determined to implement a voluntary round-up program on city-related financial transactions to support the Black Hills Children's Museum; and

WHEREAS, the City will provide an option for customers making payments to the City—whether for utilities, permits, or other services—to voluntarily round up their transaction to the nearest dollar; and

WHEREAS, the maximum round-up amount on any single transaction will be \$0.99, with the cumulative total dependent on the number and size of eligible transactions; and

WHEREAS, all funds collected through the voluntary round-up program will be transferred to Black Hills Children's Museum, Inc., for the advancement of its mission and development within the City of Box Elder; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Box Elder adopted Resolution No. 24-06 to establish a utility-only round-up program, and now wishes to expand and clarify the program's scope to include all eligible City transactions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Box Elder, That the City of Box Elder hereby establishes a voluntary round-up program applicable to all eligible financial transactions processed through the City. Participants may opt in to round up each transaction to the nearest dollar, contributing no more than \$0.99 per transaction. The funds collected will be aggregated and transferred to the Black Hills Children's Museum, Inc., on a schedule to be determined by City Staff.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Resolution No. 24-06 is hereby repealed and replaced in its entirety by this Resolution.
