1416 Sewer - Phase 1



Progress Update for this Week:

- Hydro-Klean has nearly completed manhole rehabilitation along Box Elder Rd.
 - Some tasks remain for the manhole castings.
 - Hydro-Klean will be jetting and cleaning this portion of sewer main to remove debris from construction.
- H&W has completed tie in at the east end of the project.
- H&W has installed several sections of 30-inch sewer main progressing westward in the 1416 median.

Schedule for Next Week:

- H&W will continue to install sewer main to the west.
- H&W will be installing sewer main across Oak St.
- On April 16th, the Oak Street section that crosses 1416 will be closed for the sewer main crossing to proceed.

Project Summary:

• This project is for the construction of new sewer main along Highway 1416. This is upsizing the sewer main to ensure the City of Box Elder's sewer system can facilitate additional capacity in support of future developments.

 - The first portion of Westgate Rd closed will be between the North I-90 Service Rd and Tanglewood intersections.

1416 Watermain Relocation



Progress Update for this Week:

- City crews have started stabilizing soils for equipment to successfully operate in muddy conditions near the creek.
- Utility conflicts and inaccurate locates have resulted in a slow start.
- Crews are working carefully to resolve these utility conflicts.

• Crews will begin excavating after utility locations are confirmed.

• This project is to relocate an existing watermain along Hwy 1416, just west of the 151st St intersection. Pennington County plans to remove the existing bridge and install a box culvert at the creek crossing. The watermain was found to be in tight proximity to the future box culvert.
