

1416 Sewer - Phase 1

Progress Update for this Week:

- Another manhole has been installed as progress continues west.
- The contractor has still found utilities to be near the alignment of the sewer main.
 - The contractor expects to be out of this effected area by the end of the week.
 - o This will allow progress to speed up. Estimating 200 feet of installed sewer main per day.

Schedule for Next Week:

- Work will continue west towards South Gate Road in the Hwy 14/16 median.
- All lanes on 14/16 and intersections will remain open next week.
- Due to weather delays and careful attention to utility conflicts, the South Gate Road crossing closure will be pushed back to the following week.

South Gate Road Crossing Hwy 14/16:

- South Gate Road crossing Hwy 1416 to be closed tentatively from June 9th through June 15th.
 - o Trucks are not to use Box Elder Rd and should stay on the designated detour.
- Nearby areas will also be paved during this time.
 - Oak St crossing Hwy 14/16.
 - o Box Elder Road
 - Patching around repaired manholes.
 - Patch near Vermeer on the west bound lane.

Project Summary:

This project is for the construction of new sewer main along Highway 1416. This is upsizing the sewer
main to ensure the City of Box Elder's sewer system can facilitate additional capacity in support of
future developments.

• Final Completion date: November 21, 2025.




